

AABS Accreditation Fees Structure for 2023

The below fee structure is an outline of payments due in time of each phase as part of the accreditation and re-accreditation processes. Institutions should plan and note that there will be other expenses as part of the process including mentors and accreditation visits costs which are not reflected in this document as well as internal administrative costs per each institution.

Initial Accreditation

Post-accreditation

| 3,000 USD | Due with re-accreditation self-review report submission |

Deferral Visit Policy

Institutions are responsible for all non-refundable costs associated with mentors and accreditation visits and for any re-booking charges.

Deferral Visit Fee: 1,000 USD (for initial and re-accreditation visits).
